



Homelessness Prevention & Rapid Re-Housing (HPRP)
Bartow, Cherokee, Cobb, Douglas, Pickens, & Paulding Counties

Program Intent

- To assist those who are homeless or would be homeless but for this assistance.
- To provide financial assistance to prevent renters from becoming homeless.
- To provide financial assistance to re-house former renters or former homeowners who have become homeless due to the current economic crisis.
- To help those who can remain stably housed after this temporary assistance ends.

HPRP is NOT a mortgage assistance program.
