



Group Service Projects

At MUST Ministries we place great value on the contribution that your group will make to our ministry. The following steps will insure a positive experience for your group:

ON CAMPUS

We have an assortment of special projects on our campuses, depending on the season.

NOTE: Project dates fill up very quickly.

1. Schedule your project date and time at least two weeks in advance with our Cobb Seasonal Programs Coordinator, Paula Rigsby at prigsby@mustministries.org or call 678-218-4488.
2. If needed, provide all supplies, tools and equipment to complete your project.
3. Submit release forms for the group prior to the start of the project.
4. We do allow youth between the ages of 10-17 years old to volunteer with us for some projects. They must be accompanied by a parent or adult with a release form. For youth groups, we require one adult for every 7 youth.
5. Groups are limited to 20 people due to space constraints.

NOTE: By law youth must be 16 years of age to cook a meal. We do allow youth, 12 years old or older, to help serve drinks and pass out silverware.

MUST Kits

- Shelter Guest Kit –
 - Men -zip lock bag with toothbrush, travel size toothpaste, travel size deodorant disposable razors, travel size bar of soap, travel size shampoo, travel size conditioner and travel size lotion.
 - Women -zip lock bag with toothbrush, travel size toothpaste, travel size deodorant disposable razors, travel size bar of soap, travel size shampoo, travel size conditioner and travel size lotion.
- Family Kit – bar of soap, package of razors, package of toothbrushes, toothpaste, floss and a 4 pack of tissue.
- Hair Kit – gallon size zip lock bag with large shampoo, large conditioner, comb and brush.

- Kitchen Cleanup Kit – All purpose spray cleaner, dish detergent, sponge or handi wipes.
- Laundry Basket Kit – Clothes basket with quart or gallon of powder detergent (please write on the bag the name brand- for those that may be allergic), dryer sheets, puzzle book and pencil or pen.
- First Aid Kit – Zip lock bag with sun block lotion, Band-Aids, bug repellent, first-aid ointment, anti-fungal spray, and chapstick
- Birthday Party Kit – Everything needed to have a party for 4-8 children and parents: cake mix, balloons, birthday candles, paper plates and napkins, party favors.
- Newborn Kit – Zip lock bag with diaper cream and/ or Vaseline, baby wipes and disposable diapers.
- Baby Hygiene Kit – Zip lock bag with baby shampoo, baby lotion, q-tips, nail clipper and/or nasal syringe.
- Education and Employment Packet – Pocket folder with pencil, notebook and calculator.

MUST Loaves and Fishes Community Kitchen

- Decorate lunch bags.
 - Provide baked cakes, cookies and pies for those groups who do not bring dessert.
 - Provide cookies or candies wrapped in individual packets.
 - Wrap plastic forks and spoons in a napkin. If you like, you can tie yarn or use a sticker to hold it close. NOTE: Please do not include social or religious tracts in the wrapped napkins.

Meals a-head for Breakfast

- Make breakfast sandwiches (sausage or ham on a biscuit, bagel, croissant or hard roll). You can even add egg and cheese if you would like. Wrap in aluminum foil and write the date on the package.

Meals a-head for Lunch and/or Dinner

- Make meat and cheese lunch sandwiches (no peanut butter and jelly) on white or whole wheat bread (no condiments) and place in individual zip lock bags (no fold over sandwich bags). Stack the individually wrapped sandwiches back into the bread bag and write the date on the bread bag. If your group would like to supply complete sack lunches the ingredients include: two sandwiches, one salty snack item and one sweet snack item wrapped. NOTE: Please do not include social or religious tracts in the bags.
- Make a meal ahead for 50-60 people that can be used on days when we do not have a group providing a meal. Choose something like lasagna or any other baked Italian dish that can freeze well. Double cover your dish in Saran wrap and aluminum foil. Write the date on the aluminum foil. You can also choose stews, chili, and soups in a freezable plastic container.
